

NOTICE TO PARENTS – MEAL CHARGE POLICY

All students who are eligible for a free or reduced price meal will receive meals at no cost. All students will receive breakfast at no cost. Students who do not qualify for these benefits are expected to keep their meal account balances current. It is the parent's responsibility to verify that their student has an adequate balance in his or her account. Every effort will be made to collect past due accounts from parents. If a student's account becomes delinquent they will not be identified and they will continue to receive meals. The School Secretary monitors student accounts on a weekly basis and contacts parents if an account becomes delinquent. We clear delinquent accounts at the end of each fiscal year through private donations or a contribution from the General Fund. Parents have the ability to pay for meals in the following manner:

1. Credit card or ACH payments through MySchoolBucks on-line payment system.
2. Cash or check payments paid at school office.
3. Students have the option of giving cash payments to their teacher each morning.
