UPDATE: Patterns of Strengths and Weaknesses

Reauthorization of IDEIA 2004

May not Require Severe Discrepancy

California Piloted PSW in districts throughout the state (Ventura was one)

PSW was authorized as an "alternative" method of eligibility

PSW in Santa Barbara County 2014-15

❖ Jarice Butterfield as SELPA Director organized a committee to study PSW

New Handbook of SLD Eligibility by Committee of representatives of County Districts (facilitated by Jarice Butterfield and Stacy Tolkin)

A cohort of school psychologists attended a training by Dr. Samuel Ortiz

Survey of County School Psychologists

- 90 surveyed, 40 responded
- ❖31 Use PSW because-
 - Clearer language about WHY a student is having problems
 - Points to targeted interventions
 - Works well with MTSS

Survey Results Cont'd

33 Psychologists asked for more training in PSW because-

- Psychologists seem to use it differently even in the same district
- They need more specific guidelines
- New Psychologists (since 2015) haven't had training
- Essential updates have come out

2019-2020 PSW Ad Hoc Committee Results

Importance of Consistent Practice within and across districts

Clarification of Practice Questions

Training needs to include follow-up coaching and study of PSW effectiveness for our SELPA

Training Proposal from Southern California Diagnostic Center

Two Cohorts- 15 Psychologists each, September and January

One day didactic training

Followed by ongoing coaching using actual cases

Pilot Study

Follow-up

Make these a Pilot Study for the effectiveness of PSW in our SELPA

Evaluation of results leading to revision as needed

Creation of a new SLD Eligibility Procedural Manual
