- ii. Trivium Charter Schools -** We are moving into the end year festivities – COVID-safe, of course – and our high schoolers are gearing up for finals. Currently, there is a large interest to attend Trivium in the fall and we have a long waiting list at three of our five centers. I think the waiting list may be somewhat inflated as parents are

hedging their bets depending on what their local school districts do. We are using iReady as a replacement for state testing and that is underway. Because our families have an extensive amount of curriculum choice, we typically offer a curriculum fair so families can see the curriculum options they have. Last year we threw together a virtual curriculum fair because of the sudden change in the world and this year we just rolled out a comprehensive virtual curriculum fair for our families and it has been well received. Parents have let us know that they appreciate being able to re-watch the information and scroll through the options at their own pace. So, this change will be one that stays even once C19 is a distant memory. Annette Lawrence noted that Trivium will have a small prom for their seniors.

**C. Principal’s Report** – Mr. Brown reported that current enrollment is 172 students. We are using the I-Ready testing in place of the state testing this year. We are getting good data from the program regarding how to help our students. We opened the playground last week and the students were really happy. Bussing is still an issue. We would like to try to continue without the bussing. If we don’t have the bus program, then we can offer after school tutoring. Graduation will be held on June 9<sup>th</sup>. It will be an outdoor ceremony and each student may have up to four guests.
